Summary

The most used formats for graphic files are JPEG and GIF.

Inserting an image into an HTML document is done using the tag.

The syntax of the tag is as follows:

```
<IMG src="URL_image" align="position" width="value" height="value" vspace="value" hspace="value" alt="text" border="value" >
```

where:

- src specifies the location of the image
- width and height set the dimensions of the image
- vspace and hspace set the vertical and horizontal distance from the rest of the text on the page
- align aligns the image with the text around it
- alt provides an explanatory text on the image

Images can be used as the background of the page using the background attribute of the <BODY> tag .

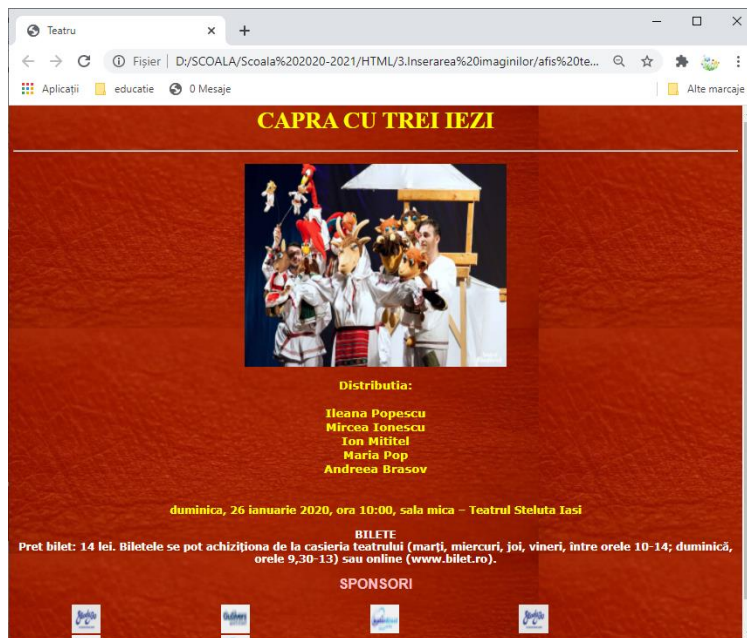
