#### **Summary**

The most used formats for graphic files are JPEG and GIF.

Inserting an image into an HTML document is done using the <IMG> tag.

The syntax of the <IMG> tag is as follows:

```
<IMG src="URL_image" align="position" width="value" height="value" vspace="value" hspace="value"  
alt="text" border="value" >
```

where:

- src specifies the location of the image
- width and height set the dimensions of the image
- vspace and hspace set the vertical and horizontal distance from the rest of the text on the page
- align aligns the image with the text around it
- alt provides an explanatory text on the image

Images can be used as the background of the page using the background attribute of the <BODY> tag .


